

The Cooking Corner

Di's veggie garden recipes:

I'm very excited about my veggie garden at the moment; after all the hard work I can finally get out there and pick all the produce we've grown.

I have a glut of eggplants at the moment, so I thought I'd share a couple of my favourite recipes using produce from my garden:

Eggplant Dip

4 – 6 medium eggplants
1 whole head of garlic
Olive oil
Lemon juice
Salt and pepper.

Wash & dry the eggplants, then cut them in half lengthways.

Trim excess paper off the garlic head, but keep it in one piece.

Put the eggplants, cut side up, and the garlic head in an ovenproof dish, and bake for about 40 minutes until the skin is soft and the flesh tender. (Or until the garlic starts to smell really fantastic).

When cool enough to handle, scoop the eggplant flesh away from the skins, and squeeze the garlic cloves out of their skins.

Add lemon juice, and salt & pepper, and pulse in a food mixer, or mash together with a fork until smooth.

Eat with warm crusty bread and a gutsy red wine!

Spicy Tomato Salsa

We also had so many tomatoes, more chillis than you could possibly use, and spring onions. This is a great way to use them up.

As many tomatoes as you need to use up

2 Spring onions or 1 red onion Juice of 1 lime Bunch of fresh coriander 2 Chillis according to taste salt

My sister-in-law from Belize insists on roasting the tomatoes & a hot habanero chilli first, which gives you an intense flavour — I quite like the freshness from using the ingredients as they are.

Throw everything in a food mixer or use a hand blender to blend to a coarse consistency – too many big chunks make it hard to pick up with a corn chip, but you don't want it too liquid either.

Eat with a bunch of friends, corn chips and cold beer.
