I am very proud and thrilled to be directing the Australian Premiere of the new Mel Brooks musical "Young Frankenstein", which will open at the Jetty Memorial Theatre, Friday April 12.

It is a HUGE show styled in the old Broadway tradition and is based on the 1974 movie of the same name.

After the success of "The Producers" it was not surprising that the famous writer/director, Mel Brooks would turn another of his successful films into a musical. He wrote the original "Young Frankenstein" film with Gene Wilder and describes it as his best film ever. As anyone who is familiar with the 1974 film would know, it is totally, ridiculously, pants-wettingly hilarious, and the musical is, if anything, even funnier.

The show features a crazy number of extremely challenging musical numbers along with a few little dance numbers as well. Getting this together has required relentless rehearsals, sweaty hard work, total commitment, patience and yes, more hard work!

We have been enjoying it too though - it is insanely over the top in every area. More slapstick that you can, well, poke a stick at; big, big musical numbers including the fantastical "Puttin' On the Ritz" featuring Dr Frankenstein's Monster, "Roll In the Hay", "He Vas My Boyfriend", "Deep Love" and "Please Don't Touch Me" which I believe holds some sort of record for the number of times the word "tits" is mentioned (14 at last count!)

Despite the workload from my extraordinary cast, we're having so much fun doing a true, side-splitting comedy, and as a bonus, it's allowed me to fulfill my dream of costuming 25 assorted bodies in 'ghostly' onesies. You just don't get better than that!

I'm often asked if this show is suitable for the whole family, and I would say that it depends on your family!

It is a Mel Brooks show, so there is plenty of smutty innuendo, sexual references and political incorrectness covering a broad spectrum of 'offenses'. I guess that's why it's so funny, but it is possibly not suitable for the very young or the extremely austere.




If you loved that cult classic, you won't want to miss this blissfully funny monster mash when it opens at the Jetty Memorial Theatre on Friday, April 12.

### The Secret Garden

This enchanting classic of children's literature is brought to life as a musical by composer Lucy Simon and the Pullitzer Prize-winning playwright, Marsha Norman. The show premiered in London in 1991, and won 3 Tony awards, including one for the 11 year old Daisy Eagan as Mary Lennox.

Orphaned in India, 11 year old Mary arrives in Yorkshire as the ward of her strange, embittered uncle, who still longs for his long-dead wife.

The huge empty house has a sad history, and holds a secret. Ghosts from Mary's past wander the halls and gardens, and many of the initial haunting melodies are sung by these spirits, or dreamers.

Left largely alone, except for the company of Martha, a warm-hearted Yorkshire housemaid, Mary turns to the garden and grounds, making friends with the gardener, and a strange boy, Dickon, who can charm all manner of birds and creatures, shows her how to bring life to the neglected garden.

When Mary meets her invalid cousin Colin, the children, both motherless, are a comfort to each other and become firm friends. Mary introduces Colin to Dickon, and the secret garden, and the children learn how to love and laugh again.

The awakening of the garden in Spring is seen alongside the new life Mary brings to both Colin and his father, changing their lives forever, and bringing them together in the touching finale.

As you can see we now have our own original artwork (from local artist and performer Christine Gray), and much thought has been going into set design concepts as well as costume solutions.



- Unfortunately there may be a lot of waiting around, so you may want to bring a book or magazine. water & some light snacks.
- If you are under 18 years of age at the time of your audition then you will need to bring a Parent or LEGAL Guardian.
