Auditions for 'A Chorus Line' are this Sunday, October 23rd, from 10am.



The auditions will be in a group setting, in a small space, with just a few friendly and supportive faces, including Chris Gooley, the director, Pete Kaukiainen as Musical Director, and Julie Ross as choreographer.

The lovely Belinda Lemair, also a choreographer, will run everyone through a short and simple routine from the opening of 'One', the big ensemble number, and you'll be asked to sing one or two lines from the song. That's it! You'll even be given the lyrics!

Whilst the show does obviously require a number of trained dancers, we also need singers, who may not be dancers, but who can be taught to follow a simple routine. If you have ever done aerobics, jazzercise, zumba, or took a few dance classes years ago - this means you!
